Take exit 102 off of I-95 and go one mile west at US 301 & 15.

Compatriot Glen Givens will speak about this most important Revolutionary War Battle. Fort Watson was the first South Carolina British Fort taken by Patriots Gen. Francis Marion and Colonel "Light Horse" Harry Lee using Maham's Tower on April 23, 1781. Attendees are invited to present wreaths.

Attendees are encouraged to all meet for lunch afterward at the Cracker Barrel in Santee. Appx 5 miles south of the fort on I-95.
